Dear Supervisors:

At our meeting of April 25, 1979, the members of the Executive Board of Branch 193, National Association of Letter Carriers, voted unanimously to commend you on your recent vote to adopt a resolution calling for either an excess profits tax on U.S. oil companies or nationalization of the American oil industry.
