Education Press Conference Jim Beall October 5, 1992

Thank you. I'm grateful for the confidence that you all have shown in me. I promise to you that I won't disappoint you if I'm elected to represent you in Sacramento.

We need a long-range strategic plan for education in this state. Not a band-aid that will get us from one crisis to the next. A Master Plan for both kindergarten through high school and for higher education.
